Europe Advance Church Planters' Roundtable

15-16 January and 22-23 January 2010

In January 2010 Europe Advance will hold two Church Planters' Roundtable (CPR), one in The Netherlands and one in Switzerland. A CPR is an introductory training for people who are interested in becoming church planters in Europe and allows them to find out more about the church planting process of Europe Advance.

Europe Advance is a brand new church planting network for Europe and is inspired by a US-based church planting network called the Association of Related Churches (ARC). ARC is one of the most dynamic church planting networks in the US. Since 2002 ARC has planted over 140 churches. Some of these churches are now among the most influential churches in the US.

This CPR will be held twice in January 2010. The first CPR will be held from Friday, January 15 (18:00 hrs), until Saturday, January 16 (17:00 hrs), in Hilversum, The Netherlands. The second CPR will be held from Friday, January 22 (18:00 hrs), until Saturday, January 23 (17:00 hrs), in Zürich, Switzerland.

The CPR is for those who are interested in becoming church planters. Their spouses are encouraged to attend. If you are a (future) church planter, it would be advisable for you to have your sponsoring church's pastor attend with you so that he can be fully informed about your vision and Europe Advance's process.

Schedule

The Roundtable begins with dinner on Friday evening, from 18:00 hrs to 21:00 hrs, and continues from 9 hrs to 17:00 hrs on Saturday (breakfast and lunch included). A guest trainer from the Association of Related Churches in the US and members of the leadership team of Europe Advance will offer this training and lead the discussion times. You can also stay around for the Sunday and attend a service in Thousand Hills Hilversum or PowerChurch in Zürich. Both churches are examples of the Europe Advance approach.

The CPR will cover topics that potential church planters will be interested in, such as:

- Where should I go?
- How do I meet people?
- Where is the best venue to get started in?
- How do I finance it...how much do I need?
- Where do I get the information that I need...where can I get the wisdom to do what I need to do?
- How do I get small groups started?
- Leadership lessons for church planters (building teams, communication, etc.)

- Natural Church Development will be presented as a way to measure the "life-giving" principles we embrace.
- and many other subjects...

Registration

The cost for both days is 100 euro per person (the wives of potential church planters attend free of charge) which includes all materials and the meals mentioned earlier. Your registration will be finalized when the payment is received.

Also, let us know if you are planning to go to the one in Holland or the one in Switzerland, where you intend on planting a church and how many people will be joining you to the CPR. We will then send you more information about accommodation and registration fees and about how to prepare for this CPR.
